Complications, or maloccurrence, are part of the practice of medicine and certainly part of surgical intervention. Whether the term 'accepted complication' or 'recognized complication' is used, inadvertent outcomes do happen and frequently are not a result of negligence or any wrong doing by the surgeon.

Preventable medical errors, such as complications of surgery have become a central focus in healthcare. In the 'Institute of medicine' report between 50,000 and 1,00,000 people are estimated to die every year in USA hospitals from preventable medical errors. The safety systems surrounding surgery are indeed fallible.

Laparoscopic surgery promises patients less discomfort and a speedier recovery than has ever been possible with open surgery. But like all other types of surgery, it does carry some risk of serious permanent injury. Compounding factors include the impact of new technology, lack of appropriate training and unrealistic expectations by some patients for perfect results.

This conference is about catastrophes, disasters and accidents: from vascular to thermal injuries, bladder to uretric injuries, small to large bowel injuries and even death.

Do you think that every major complication that we experience is unforeseen, an unavoidable misfortune that no one could have possibly imagined? No! In fact all of them, it turns out, were accidents waiting to happen. The events were not "really accidental" at all.

The best way to reduce the incidence of surgical complications is to enhance physician training. If we have to avoid the kinds of disasters and catastrophes that occur in surgery, we first need to understand them.

Beams presents a two-day conference which shows that, in the real world, most patients are not harmed by malice but by risk blindness i.e. the failure to see potential harm and imminent danger, until it is too late.
